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DRIVING DIRECTIONS

TO SANSEPOLCRO FROM POINTS WEST, SUCH AS FIRENZE, LUCCA, AND PISA.

At Lucca, join the A11 Autostrada for Firenze, which merges with the A1 to Rome just before you get to Firenze. If you are leaving the Florence Airport take a hard right immediately on leaving the airport. You are now on the Autostrada approach road. There is an exit for Sestino, then a garage if you need fuel for a hire car. The next exit to the right says Roma/ Bologna and the road wanders through some industrial wasteland to the autostrada gates. Take the one to the extreme left, and keep in the left lane following signs for ROMA. The road goes over a bridge to the highway and you need to merge right as soon as you enter.

After leaving Firenze on the Autostrada heading south towards Rome but you will be aiming for AREZZO

Leave the Autostrada at the AREZZO exit about 20-30 mins after Florence.

There is about a 10 K drive along a straight feeder road towards Arezzo after you leave the Autostrada. You pass through a longish industrial district and when you pass the sign for Arezzo and when you can see the town on the hill in front of you look for signs to SANSEPOLCRO. The road takes you almost to the town itself but stops suddenly and you will need to take a left at a traffic light, to swing around to the right which is your eventual direction on a ring road around the bottom of the town. So make sure you are in the middle lane. Go straight ahead through two roundabouts (keep to the centre lane) and a set of traffic lights until you come to an omni directional sign that looks like an octopus, directing you to the right. Beware as the traffic is suddenly two way. Siena is to the right and SANSEPOLCRO is to the left, and that is the direction you want to follow.

You should now be on the S73 (although it is sometimes called the S 78) which is the main road from Arezzo to Sansepolcro. Once you are on this road it heads up hill and over onto a new stretch of superstrada that winds through a long (and beautiful) valley for about 20 K . At a small town called Le Ville there is a left fork for SANSEPOLCRO and a right for Citta di Castello (Monterchi, Lippiano. Towards SS and 1 K further on there is the turn off to CITERNA on your right. Another k and the turn off for ANGHIARI is on your left. Sansepolcro is about 6 k straight ahead.
